

YUCCA LODGE AT FORT BAYARD MEDICAL CENTER ADMISSION CRITERIA

CLINICALLY MANAGED HIGH-INTENSITY RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT OF CHEMICAL DEPENDENCE--MENTAL HEALTH ENHANCED (ASAM III.5)

CLINICALLY MANAGED DETOX (ASAM III.2D)

1. Only voluntary admissions are accepted. Individuals who are court-ordered to treatment will be considered for admission if they otherwise meet admission criteria.
2. Individuals will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
3. Individuals must be 18 years of age or older, cooperative and nonviolent.
4. Individuals must have a primary AXIS I diagnosis of substance dependence.
5. Individuals with a secondary mental health diagnosis must be compliant with all medications and stable enough to participate in and benefit from treatment.
6. All medical and dental problems and medications must be disclosed and discussed prior to admission to insure individual safety.
 - a. Yucca Lodge is not staffed with 24-hour medical personnel and does not provide acute care.
 - b. Yucca Lodge is not licensed to dispense opiates, benzodiazepines, barbiturates or other controlled substances.
 - c. In order to document program eligibility and appropriateness, individuals may be asked to provide medical or mental health records or other information during pre-admission screening and will not be admitted if requested information is not provided.
7. No individual will be admitted with pending legal obligations including pending incarceration.
8. No individual will be admitted who has a relative or close acquaintance currently in treatment at or working at Yucca Lodge.
9. Individuals reporting the following at intake assessment will NOT be admitted:
 - a. A sustained, high level of alcohol, opiate or sedative/hypnotic use in the 10 days prior to intake or long-term benzodiazepine use.*
 - b. Withdrawal symptoms requiring medical treatment.
 - c. Medically significant intoxication, lethargy or hypersomnolence due to intoxication.
 - d. Suicidal or homicidal ideation or other unstable psychiatric illness requiring acute treatment
 - e. A third trimester pregnancy or an unstable/not medically cleared pregnancy in first or second trimester.
 - f. Significant medical illness or other medical situation deemed unstable by medical officer.
10. Individuals will be admitted to clinically managed, *non-medical* detoxification for stimulant and barbiturate use on a case-by-case basis. Individuals will NOT be admitted to detoxification for alcohol, opiate, sedative/hypnotic or long-term benzodiazepine use.*
